**Background/Analysis:**

The Minneapolis School Based Clinic Program was selected in fall 2015 to participate with over 28 other school based health care centers on the National Quality Improvement ( NQI) Initiative Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Network ( COIIN) to measure and address sustainable business practices . The National School Based Health Care Alliance is providing stipends for participation and for staff to attend National Conference in June 2017.
