The Minneapolis School Based Clinic Program was selected in fall 2015 to participate with over 28 other school based health care centers on the National Quality Improvement (NQI) Initiative Collaborative Improvement and Innovation Network (COIIN) to measure and address sustainable business practices . The National School Based Health Care Alliance is providing stipends for participation and for staff to attend National Conference in June 2017.
