MANAGER

The manager of Bottle & Bottega Minneapolis will be Christine Myers. Ms. Myers has worked at Bottle & Bottega in Chicago as an Artist and Assistant Manager and has passed the criminal background check.

POLICE REVIEW

Police licensing have reviewed the expenses and source of funds reported in this application. The applicant has provided documentation showing adequate legal and traceable funding for this venture and has passed the criminal background check. The Fifth Precinct of the Minneapolis Police Department has discussed security issues with the applicant.

PREMISES

The lease shows exclusive use of premises by applicant. The licensed premises are on the ground floor of the building. The premises occupy approximately 1936 square feet. There is seating for 89 people at tables and chairs. There is no outdoor area.

BUSINESS PLAN/OPERATIONS

The business shall be mainly for the teaching of the art medium, painting. Bottles and Bottega schedules both private and public events. The restaurant and painting will be open to the public. They will be allowed up to one non amplified musician.

The hours of operation for the establishment will be 5:00 pm to on 10:00pm Monday through Friday. The hours of operation will be 10:00am to 10:00pm on Saturday and Sundays 11:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. on Sunday.

Management will take whatever steps are necessary to manage the noise level and minimize the disturbance to local residences. There are no outdoor speakers. The business closes at 10:00 p.m. daily.

There will be no mechanical amusement devices or team sponsorships.

No charitable gambling is anticipated.

PUBLIC HEARING SUMMARY
