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**FINDINGS OF FACT

This matter came before the Division of Licenses and Consumer Services at a License Settlement Conference on Tuesday, October 21, 2014 at 10:00 am in Room 107, Minneapolis City Hall. Appearing on behalf of the licensee was Christian Orosz. Appearing for the City of Minneapolis were Linda Roberts, Assistant Manager of Licenses and Consumer Services, and Amy Duncan, License Inspector. Based on information presented at the hearing, the Division makes the following findings of fact, conclusions, and recommendations:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Lulu's Street Food has held a Mobile Food Vehicle Vendor license since 2013.
2. On October 18, 2013, the Lulu's Street Food truck was parked on the 700 block of Marquette Avenue at 8:51am. This is not an approved operating location until 9:00am due to parking restrictions.
3. On May 5, 2014, the Lulu's Street Food truck was parked on the 700 block of Marquette Avenue at 8:50am. This is not an approved operating location until 9:00am due to parking restrictions.

4. On August 13, 2014, the Lulu's Street Food truck was parked on the 700 block of Marquette Avenue at 8:50am. This is not an approved operating location until 9:00am due to parking restrictions.

CONCLUSIONS

1. On three separate occasions in a ten month period, the Lulu's Street Food truck was found to be in violation of Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 188485(c), requiring mobile food vehicles to operate in approved locations in the City.
2. On October 18, 2013, May 5, 2014, and August 13, 2014, the Lulu's Street Food truck was found to be in violation of Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 259.250(2), requiring a licensee to operate the business in compliance with all applicable laws and ordinances.
3. Lulu's Street Food truck has paid the \$200 fine related to the administrative citation issued on May 5, 2013 and the \$400 fine related to the administrative citation issued on August 13, 2014.

RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on evidence presented at the hearing, the Division makes the following recommendation:

1. Lulu's Street Food agrees to a 6 month suspension from operating its mobile food vehicle on Marquette Avenue upon approval of these Findings of Fact by the Minneapolis City Council effective from the date of the hearing, October 21, 2014,

Christian Orosz understands that the holding of a business or liquor license in the City of Minneapolis is both a privilege and a responsibility. A minimum standard shall be met in order to hold such a license. One minimum standard is that a license holder is responsible to ensure that its business operates in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations. It is understood and agreed that any violation of the above Recommendations shall constitute just and proper cause for the immediate imposition of any stayed penalties. It is further understood that compliance with the above Recommendations is a requirement for continuing to hold a license and that failure to comply with any of these conditions may result in additional adverse license action.

I have read and understand the above findings of fact, conclusions, and recommendations. I agree with their contents and I agree with the above noted Recommendations. I understand that the failure of my business to adhere to this agreement may be cause for further suspension, revocation, or denial of my license. I understand that this report must be accepted and approved by the Minneapolis City Council and Mayor.
