This matter came before a License Settlement Conference hearing on Thursday, June 4, 2015 at 10:30 AM in Room 107, Minneapolis City Hall. Appearing on behalf of the licensee was David Menter, Owner, Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro. Appearing for the City of Minneapolis were Grant Wilson, Manager of Licenses and Consumer Services, Craig Eliason, District Supervisor, Dan Jacobs, License Inspector, and Shari Pierzina, Fire Inspector. Based on the evidence presented at the hearing, the department makes the following findings of fact:

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1) Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro has held a Duct Cleaner license since May, 2012.
- 2) Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro violated Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 174.500, in that they have not provided date stamped photos of each completed job.
- 3) Hoods of Twin Cities North Metro have unpaid citations totaling \$ 7200.00.

CONCLUSION

- 1) Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro violated Minneapolis Code of Ordinances 174.500 by failing to providing photos of each hood cleaning job they performed.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- 1) Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro agrees to pay a \$ 7200.00 sanction for failing to provide stamped dated photos of completed work. \$ 5200.00 of the sanction is stayed pending no same or similar violations for a period of one year from the signing of this document. The \$ 2000.00 sanction must be paid by July 1, 2015.
- 2) Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro agrees to provide photos of all work done on permits dating back to January 1, 2014, no later than August 1, 2015.

Hoodz of Twin Cities North Metro understands that the holding of a business or liquor license in the City of Minneapolis is both a privilege and a responsibility. A minimum standard shall be met in order to hold such a license. One minimum standard is that a license holder is responsible to ensure that its business operates in compliance with all applicable laws, ordinances, and regulations. It is understood and agreed that any violation of the above Recommendations shall constitute just and proper cause for the immediate imposition of any stayed penalties. It is further understood that compliance with the above Recommendations is a requirement for continuing to hold a license and that failure to comply with any of these conditions may result in additional adverse license action.

I have read and understand the above findings of fact, conclusions, and recommendations. I agree with their contents and I agree with the above noted Recommendations. I understand that the failure of my business to adhere to this agreement may be cause for further suspension, revocation, or denial of my license. I understand that this report must be accepted and approved by the Minneapolis City Council and Mayor.
