**Subject:**

Collective Bargaining Agreement – Trades Inspectors Bargaining Unit – 2016 through 2018

**Description:**

1. Approving the collective bargaining agreement with the Minneapolis Building and Construction Trades Council, AFL-CIO, Trades Inspectors Unit, for the period January 1, 2016 through December 31, 2018.
