9th St S, 11th St N-S, 12th St N-S and 7th Av N Street Resurfacing Project No 5273: Assessment cancellation

Description:

1. Passage of Resolution cancelling a street resurfacing special assessment for property identified as PID 27-029-24-12-0193, at 1012 LaSalle Av in the amount of \$119.04 for the Street Resurfacing Project No 5273 (CPV15619TH) for payable 2016 and subsequent years' tax files.
2. Passage of Resolution amending Resolution 2015R-121 entitled "Ordering the work to proceed and adopting the special assessments for the 9th St S, 11th St N-S, 12th St N-S and 7th Av N Street Resurfacing Project," passed March 20, 2015 to decrease the total amount of special assessments by \$119.04.

Previous Actions:

March 20, 2015 – Resolution 2015R-121 adopting the 9th St S, 11th St N-S, 12th St N-S and 7th Av N assessment rolls.

November 20, 2015 – Resolution 2015R-481 levying 2015 Public Works Dept. assessments and directing transmission of the assessment rolls to Hennepin County.

Background/Analysis:

The purpose of this letter is to request cancellation of a Public Works Department street resurfacing special assessment for payable 2016 and subsequent years' tax files for property at 1012 LaSalle Av, identified as Property ID 27-029-24-12-0193 in the total amount of \$119.04. The property owner for this parcel, as listed in the Hennepin County records, is the University of St. Thomas; indicating this property is privately owned and as private property is assessable for street resurfacing improvements. However, since the public hearing for this street resurfacing project, we have learned this property is in fact City of Minneapolis right-of-way used for public sidewalk. As public right-of-way, this parcel should be exempt from the list of properties that were assessed for the street resurfacing project.

Financial Review:

No additional appropriation required, amount included in current budget.

Shortfall will be managed through the capital project closeout process.
