Critical traffic and parking area application: 10th Ave S from 21st St E to 22nd St E and 21st St E from 10th Ave S to 11th Ave S

Description:

1. Receiving a report on the sufficiency of an application requesting that the area be designated a critical traffic and parking area thereby restricting parking between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. daily, except by permit.
2. Referring the application to the Public Works Director.
3. Directing the Public Works Director to conduct a traffic and parking survey of the traffic conditions in the vicinity of the proposed zone, and report back to Committee with a recommendation based on a verification of proper "findings" and compliance with qualifying criteria.

Background/Analysis:

Pursuant to the provisions of Section [478.710](#) of the Code, a written application to establish a critical traffic and parking area has been received by the Office of City Clerk. One resident in each of at least 75 percent of the dwelling units located within the proposed critical traffic and parking area shall be required before the City Council may consider the designation of a specified area.

I have verified that 26 signatures on the application are valid, a figure which is more than the 75 percent required of the 31 dwelling units in the proposed area.
