Authorizing Amendment No. 1 to the MnDOT Contract No. 1001508 for Architectural History Review of the Downtown Pedestrian Improvement Project.

Whereas, the City received \$875,000 in federal matching funds for the Downtown Pedestrian Improvement Project. A Project Memorandum includes a historical review of the properties in the project area. MnDOT offered to coordinate this work with their own Cultural Resources Unit and will pay for 80% of the work. MnDOT has requested additional time for the historical review. Amendment No. 1 to MnDOT Contract No. 1001508 extends the terms of the contract by 12 months and the project schedule by 18 months;

Now, Therefore, Be It Resolved by The City Council of The City of Minneapolis:

That the proper City officials be authorized to execute Amendment 1 to Contract No. 1001508 with the State of Minnesota department of Transportation for the architectural historical review for the Downtown Pedestrian Improvement Project, extending the expiration date by 12 months and the project schedule by 18 months.
