1. amend contract # 29002 with Hennepin County to accept revenue not to exceed \$720,000 over a four year period from a federal Teen Pregnancy Prevention grant, and
2. increase both the revenue estimate in fund/department 01300-8600152 (revenue code 321007) and the 2011 appropriation in fund/department 01300-8600152 by \$720,000.

**Background/Supporting Information Attached**

Hennepin County was awarded a five year Federal Health and Human Services Grant to implement and evaluate a clinic based teen pregnancy prevention intervention, "It's your future – Safer Sex Program". The County contracted with the City for the first year for a portion of the services, and the School Based Clinics provided enhanced health education sessions to participating teens in the six school clinic sites. The amendment provides for additional funding for the balance of the four years of the grant.
