## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

**RE:** Amendments to the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Grocery Stores.

On Wednesday, July 25<sup>th</sup>, 2007 at 1:00 p.m. or shortly thereafter, the Public Safety and Regulatory Services Committee of the Minneapolis City Council will consider the following amendments to the Code of Ordinances:

*An ordinance amending Title 13, Chapter 188 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Administration and Licensing, by adding thereto a new Section 188.185, establishing minimum standards and qualifications of applicants for food and beverage licenses.*

*An ordinance amending Title 13, Chapter 203 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Grocery Stores and Specialty Food Stores, by adding thereto a new sub section 203.20 (c.), establishing requirements for minimum staple food items in grocery stores.*

*An ordinance amending Title 13, Chapter 259, of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances, Licenses and Business Regulations, In General, by amending section 259.125 to establish business premise maintenance requirements, amending 259.135 regarding mandates to post license conditions, and amending 259.15 regarding payment of fines and fees as a condition of licensure.*
