

Subject: Permission to Execute a Joint Powers Agreement –with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Emergency Response Commission to Provide Bomb Disposal Services

Recommendation: That the proper city officials be authorized to execute a Joint Powers contract agreement with the Minnesota Department of Public Safety – Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Management. The Department also requests an amendment to the general appropriation resolution for 2011 in the amount of \$54,000. The agreement for reimbursement for bomb disposal service calls up to \$54,000 will operate through the Revenue Fund, 0100-4002720.

Previous Directives: The Police Department has received reimbursement for out-state bomb disposal response since 2002.
