Letter of Agreement

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis (hereinafter, "City") and Minneapolis City Supervisor's Association (hereinafter, "Association") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement; and

Whereas, a new position titled Manager Field Operations Housing Inspections has been established and evaluated at 513 total points, grade 11 of the Inspections Promotional Line;

Now, therefore, be it resolved:

That, the classification Manager Field Operations Housing Inspections grade 11, shall be recognized by the parties as a position for which the Association is the sole and exclusive certified collective bargaining representative; and

That, the classification Manager Field Operations Housing Inspections, grade 11, shall be integrated into the salary schedule of the Association as follows:

Effective August 7, 2015 (eligible for any ATB provided to other unit jobs in 2015)

That, the classification of Manager Field Operations Housing Inspections grade 11, is recognized as exempt, code 1, for purposes of the Fair Labor Standards Act; and
