
# Schedule




# Existing Conditions





# Feedback Received

- Keeping parking on both sides is important
  - High demand with Islamic Center
- Parked cars may block driveways
- Include a buffer for the bike lanes
  - Similar cross section to the proposed county segment (Lake to 46<sup>th</sup> St)
- Improve Pedestrian Safety at the Intersection of 24<sup>th</sup> and Minnehaha
  - Safe Routes to school
  - Signal Replacement

# Other items still to be considered

- Intersection of 24<sup>th</sup>
  - Removal of slip-lane (south bound right turn lane)
  - Expansion of existing pork-chop island
  - Mast-arm signals
  - (The reconstruction project will include replacement of the signal system.)
- Street Lighting
  - Installation of an underground lighting system would be 100% assessed to the properties in the influence zone
  - A petition will be mailed to property owners in the influence zone
