qualifications & experience

All Public Works Service Worker Trainee applicants must be at least 18 years of age by **October 31, 2016** and possess a high school diploma, GED or Equivalent. Must also possess and maintain a valid Minnesota Class D driver's license with the ability to obtain a Class B Commercial driver's license **with tanker endorsement** within 6 month of employment.

All applicants must successfully complete an agility test, reading and math assessment, as well as a pre-employment medical exam and drug and alcohol screening.
