Grant Acceptance from Bush Foundation for youth engagement

Description:

Background/Analysis:

The Bush Foundation dedicates a limited amount of funds every year to sponsor select events that inspire, equip and connect people to think bigger and think differently about what's possible in their communities. They believe Minneapolis will become more resilient and innovative as a result of leaders who are better equipped and better connected to effectively lead change.

These funds will go towards a Minneapolis Youth Day of Action scheduled for January 14, 2017. This event will be in partnership with Cities United and the Bush Foundation to bring a day of hands-on learning about social impact and leadership with an emphasis on youth violence prevention and healing trauma.
