Local Approval Requirement; Liquor License for a restaurant located at 5000 Hiawatha Avenue

Description:

Approving as required by Minnesota Statutes 645.021 special legislation authorizing the issuance of an on-sale license for a restaurant located at 5000 Hiawatha Ave for the sale of intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises.

Background/Analysis:

The 2016 Legislature passed special legislation authorizing 5 liquor licenses including one located in Minneapolis (5000 Hiawatha Ave). Minnesota law requires that special legislation must be approved by the local government in which the license is located. The City has in past years approved special liquor law authorizing liquor licenses for approximately 20 locations throughout the cities. The special law licenses have been authorized for museums, theaters, art centers and restaurants.

The approval of the legislation is separate from the approvals necessary to issue this liquor license. The owners of the restaurant will need to apply for the liquor license.
