

**RESOLUTION

Approving Laws of Minnesota 2016 regular Legislative Session, Chapter 189, Article 4, Section 21

Whereas the Minnesota State Legislature has passed a law authorizing the City of Minneapolis to issue an on-sale intoxicating liquor license to a restaurant located at 5000 Hiawatha Avenue for the sale of intoxicating liquor for consumption on the premises, subject to the hours and days of sale restriction in Minnesota Statutes, section 340A.504, and any reasonable restrictions imposed by the licensing authority; and

Whereas, said legislation, by its terms requires an affirmative vote of a majority of the members of the City Council by the first day of the next regular session of the legislature before it may become effective;

Now, therefore, Be It Resolved by the City Council of Minneapolis:

That the said law be now approved and the City Clerk be directed to prepare and file with the Secretary of State the required certification of approval.
