Frequently Asked Questions

Alternative Consequences for Gross Misdemeanor Carrying a Pistol Request for Applications

Question 1. Can we assume that referrals to this program will come periodically and one at a time, as offenders are convicted of the gross misdemeanor?

Answer 1. Yes. The referrals would be made one at a time as each individual case is resolved in court.

Question 2. We understand the program is to have the intensity of a 30-day incarceration; is there a preference for the alternative program to also last 30 days? Or is a shorter or longer length of program an option as long as it offers sufficient intensity to assist referrals?

Answer 2. There is no preference as to the length of the program. Each program will be evaluated based on all the components offered.

Question 3. Should submission of the grant include the signed "Standard Agreement Form for professional services and Exhibit A, or are those for our information only at this time?

Answer 3. The submission does not need to include the Standard Agreement Form or Exhibit A. It is to make the applicant aware of the requirements that will be asked of them if they are selected.
